- Determines scope of work for our trade and determines vague areas to qualify bids.
- Develops comprehensive, detailed proposal for the project estimated
- Posts bid negotiations with client and K&K Sales staff to determine final scopes of work and assigns values to items that may be revised or deleted.
- Posts bid "value engineering" to help negotiate final contract with K&K Sales staff and client.
- Assists Project Management staff with pricing issues on major project revisions.
